

MOUTH ULCERS - STOMATITIS

(ISS MED/3A - ALL/FIN)

SYMPTOMS

Painful lesion on oral mucosa, frequently following mucosal injury or irritation

SIGNS

Raised lesion on oral mucosa, often with a central yellow crater

TREATMENT

AMP
(blue) Kenalog in Orabase (Triamcinolone Acetonide) (P2-A18) - Topical
steroid ointment for treatment of mouth ulcers

Dose: Apply ointment with finger to affected area after meals and before
sleeping until completely resolved.

___-4 Faringosept Oral Lozenges

Dose: 1 lozenge dissolved under the tongue 3 to 5 times/day

NOTE

Dissolve lozenge in mouth at least 15 minutes
after meal.
