

DENTAL - TEMPORARY FILLING

(ISS MED/3A - ALL/FIN)

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NOTE

1. Use only if missing portion of filling or tooth does not include an exposed pulp.
2. If dental pulp exposed, refer to {DENTAL - EXPOSED PULP} (SODF: ISS MED: DENTAL).

AMP
(blue)

1. Unstow:
 - Carver File (Dental-1)
 - Gauze Pads (P3-B4)
 - Temporary Filling (Dental-10)
 - Non-Sterile Gloves (P3-B2)
2. Puncture end of Temporary Filling tube using other end of cap on the filling material tube.
3. Don Non-Sterile Gloves.
4. Squeeze Temporary Filling material onto finger.
5. Gently place filling in tooth cavity, wiping off excess with Gauze Pads.
6. Bite and rub teeth together, then open mouth.
Adjust filling as needed.
Remove and smooth excess filling using Gauze Pads and Carver File.
7. Allow 5 minutes for initial set.

NOTE

Eating or drinking may be resumed within 20 minutes to 1 hour of initial set; however, it is best to avoid using tooth for at least 24 hours since material is not very strong.

8. Notify Surgeon.
